  - Mike donated the winnings back to the club, THANKS MIKE!


#### > First Annual CNEW Gala

### Alex's finishing process:

Water to raise the grain, lightly sand, Aniline water-based dye, HVLP setup used to spray 7-8 coats of lacquer then bowling alley wax is applied and buffed







